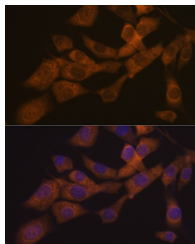

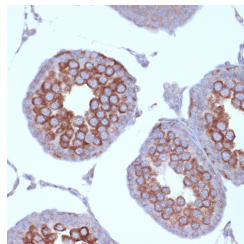

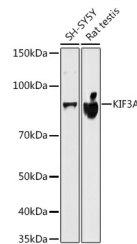

Immunofluorescence analysis of NIH-3T3 cells using KIF3A Rabbit monoclonal antibody (STJ11103614) at dilution of 1:100 (40x lens). Blue: DAPI for nuclear staining.



Immunohistochemistry analysis of paraffin-embedded rat testis using KIF3A Rabbit monoclonal antibody (STJ11103614) at dilution of 1:100 (40x lens). Perform microwave antigen retrieval with 10 mM Tris/EDTA buffer pH 9.0 before commencing with immunohistochemistry staining protocol.



Western blot analysis of extracts of various cell lines, using KIF3A antibody (STJ11103614) at 1:500 dilution. Secondary antibody: HRP Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG (H+L) (STJ5000856) at 1:10000 dilution. Lysates/proteins: 25 µg per lane. Blocking buffer: 3% nonfat dry milk in TBST. Detection: ECL Basic Kit. Exposure time: 10s.
