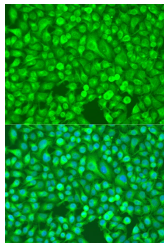

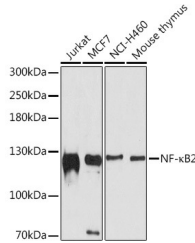

Exposure time: 30s.
