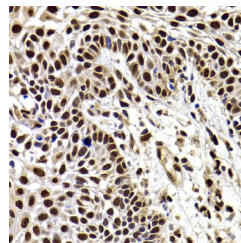

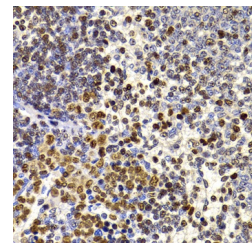
Immunofluorescence analysis of U2OS cells using HIRIP3 antibody (STJ29094).
