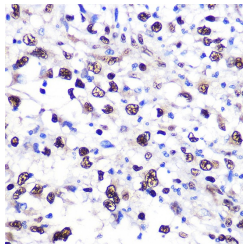

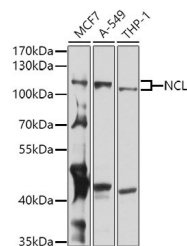

Immunohistochemistry analysis of paraffin-embedded human liver cancer tissue using NCL Rabbit polyclonal antibody (STJ29927) at dilution of 1:100 (40x lens). Perform microwave antigen retrieval with 10 mM PBS buffer pH 7.2 before commencing with immunohistochemistry staining protocol.



Western blot analysis of extracts of various cell lines, using NCL antibody (STJ29927) at 1:1000 dilution. Secondary antibody: HRP Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG (H+L) (STJS000856) at 1:10000 dilution. Lysates/proteins: 25 Mu g per lane. Blocking buffer: 3% nonfat dry milk in TBST. Detection: ECL Basic Kit. Exposure time: 30s.
