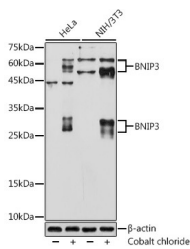

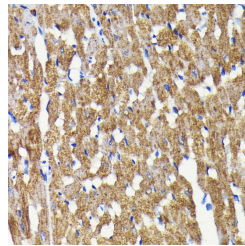

HeLa cells and NIH/3T3 cells were treated by Cobalt chloride (0.1 mM) at 37 °C for 4 hours. Secondary antibody: HRP Goat Anti-rabbit IgG (H+L) at 1:10000 dilution. Lysates/proteins: 25ug per lane. Blocking buffer: 3% nonfat dry milk in TBST. Detection: ECL Basic Kit. Exposure time: 30s.
