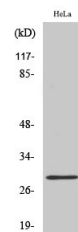

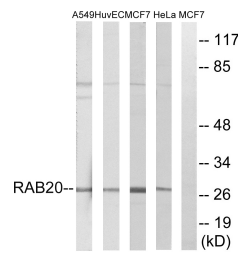

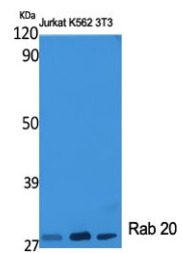
Western blot analysis of the lysates from HeLa cells using RAB20 antibody.
