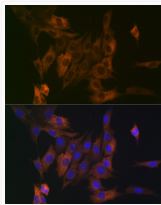

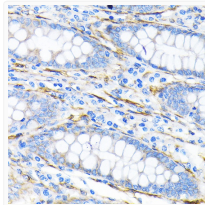

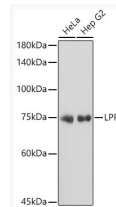

Immunofluorescence analysis of NIH/3T3 cells using LPP Rabbit monoclonal antibody (STJ11102958) at dilution of 1:100 (40x lens). Blue: DAPI for nuclear staining.



Immunohistochemistry analysis of paraffin-embedded human liver cancer using LPP Rabbit monoclonal antibody (STJ11102958) at dilution of 1:100 (40x lens). Perform microwave antigen retrieval with 10 mM Tris/EDTA buffer pH 9.0 before commencing with immunohistochemistry staining protocol.



Western blot analysis of extracts of various cell lines, using LPP antibody (STJ11102958) at 1:1000 dilution. Secondary antibody: HRP Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG (H+L) (STJS000856) at 1:10000 dilution. Lysates/proteins: 25 Mu g per lane. Blocking buffer: 3% nonfat dry milk in TBST. Detection: ECL Basic Kit. Exposure time: 5s.
